Update on the assessment grant- Chesapeake Bay Office of USFWS gave us \$5000.00 for the sediment component of Rocky's assessment.

Report on PA Fish and Boat Commission AES grant: they met on 8/8/04 but we have still not heard regarding our grant request for the Cornwall playground stream stabilization work.

Scheduled work days: Bill and Don will do the site visit to check out the location of tires and to prioritize locations. They will use Bill's topo map to indicate locations of tires. If we identify 50-70 tires Randy Ebersole should be willing to accept the tires. We might even consider giving him some money to defray the costs of disposal. Kyle's kids- Matt, Liz and Becky can identify tires from the Cleona playground to Spruce street in Annville. The actual date for removal will depend on the water level.

Ralph Heister is interested in doing a water quality study with his high school biology students. He wants to review the locations of Rocky's water testing to select sites. Note: Rocky's SITES ARE IN THE PRELIMINARY REPORT ON PAGE 99 WHICH IS ON OUR WEBSITE.

Date for tree planting- Saturday, 10/9/04 – possible sites: Copenhaver Farm, Cleona Pumping Station, Bucher Farm and Forney Farm.

We still need to move the rock into the stream banks in the Quittie Creek Nature Park. Kyle will check with people at the high school and Dave will check with people at the college Jim Monos, Peg Kauffman, Lisa Fiorvanti.
