Meeting Minutes

June 20, 2017

The meeting began at 7:00 PM.

1. Mike provided an update on the work of Association intern Sam Soliday, who is surveying and photo-documenting the Upper Snitz Creek in collaboration with Rocky Powell.
2. Kent suggested that the Association reach out to Shippensburg University to identify future interns. Kent volunteered to draft a letter to area colleges and universities to solicit unpaid internships.
3. Kent noted that Doc Fritchey Trout Unlimited has scheduled a cleanup on Snitz Creek on Saturday, Aug. 26, focusing on removal of invasive species.
4. Kelly raised the question of videos for schools and the general public to publicize and make more widely known the work of the Association. A robust discussion ensued. Questions such as target audience, content, and whether we should produce bilingual videos were discussed. Kelly volunteered to craft an initial video introducing the Association for the Association's review.
5. Terri Fanz-Falzone, who lives on South Mill St. in the old mill house that straddles the creek, shared her experiences with trash and related watershed issues.
6. Consensus was reached that the July meeting should be canceled, and that our next meeting will be in August.

The meeting adjourned at 8:02 PM.
