This document, along with the information contained in the grant agreement document itself, provides valuable information to direct you in your efforts to carry out this grant. Below are some issues of high importance which are covered in more detail in the attached Grant Guidance and grant agreement documents.

The Department will fund the project on a reimbursement basis consistent with the approved simplified budget (attached). Payment shall be requested by submitting the 319 NPS Application for Reimbursement, 319 NPS Application for Reimbursement Supplemental Sheet and 319 NPS Project Status Report. These forms are required to be used for this and future grants. If you have older, active 319 grants with the Department, please use these reimbursement forms and project status report to maximize effectiveness as well as to facilitate processing of your reimbursement request. Instructions on completing and submitting the Application for Reimbursement, Application for Reimbursement Supplemental Sheet and Project Status Report can be found in the Grants Guidance. It is advised that you follow the instructions carefully.

Failure to properly submit a reimbursement request may result in a considerable delay in payment. In addition to the Grants Guidance document, the enclosed Checklist for Completing 319 NPS Application for Reimbursement should help you when the time comes to submit a reimbursement request.

Electronic versions of the 319 NPS Application for Reimbursement, 319 NPS Application for Reimbursement Supplemental Sheet and 319 Project Status Report forms can be obtained by contacting your DEP Central Office Project Advisor.

Lastly, please note that EPA's Section 319 grants cannot fund any projects or activities that are specifically identified as part of a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program permit such as for a Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation (CAFO) or a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4). These grants also cannot fund any farms producing or utilizing manure that are not covered by a nutrient or manure management plan.
