Quittapahilla Creek Watershed Association, Lebanon

County--Watershed Protection Award, given to an organization or individual that has promoted the protection of a particular watershed through a coordinated land and water resource approach. Founded in 1997, the Quittapahilla Creek Watershed Association monitors water quality along the creek and its four major tributaries. The association has worked with various community groups and state, federal, and local agencies on a number of stream restoration and water quality monitoring projects. With a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development, the association is helping to restore an existing wetland and to design an educational wetland center. The State Conservation Commission sponsors this award.
