1. Update on PA Fish and Boat Commission's AES grant for the Cornwall playground stream stabilization work- we received the \$10,000 from PA Fish & Boat.

Don Thomas wrote a grant to AES for the work on the sites that Karl Lutz visited on April 15<sup>th</sup> : Mill Street, Quittie Park, and the house on S. White Oak St. (Catherine Esh) at the Bridge on Route 934

2. The year's activity since the last meeting:

A. Thirty-five individuals from Phil Haven's day program from ages 6 to 14 took a tour of the Quittie Creek Nature Park.

B. We are looking at the runoff at Woodside and proposing a correction to the problem.

C. Still waiting for the permit to be approved for the work in Cornwall.

3. Chuck Wertz said that the Conservation District would accept the tree protectors and provide them to landowners in need of them. Dave will see what is needed to get them to Chuck.
4. A student, Joe Lannon, did his Eagle Badge Project in the Quittie Park on 6/18/05. His project included planting rooted basket willow, stream stabilization, and putting up bird houses.
