Meeting Minutes

Special Meeting: Rocky Powell's Watershed Implementation Plan Public Unveiling Annville Town Hall

Wednesday, September 26, 2018

This special public meeting from 7:00 to 9:30 p.m. was given over to a presentation by Rocky Powell of Clear Creeks Consulting, LLP, on his recently completed Quittapahilla Creek Watershed Implementation Plan.

Approximately 20 persons were in attendance. QWA Members present were Mike Schroeder, Karen Feather, Alicia Norris, Alan Wood, Kent Crawford, Bill Wall, Joseph Connors, and Russ Collins. Other persons present were Laurie Crawford (Executive Director, The Lebanon Valley Conservancy), Ned Gibble (President, TLVC), Bill Ames (Leb. Co. Commissioner), Bob Phillips (Leb. Co. Commissioner), George Dodson, Owen Moe, Nayab Baloch (LVC student), Kendall Lu (LVC student), Richa Patel (LVC student), and three persons unidentified.

The meeting began at 7:00 p.m. Rocky offered an approximately 120-minute Power Point presentation summarizing the principal features of the WIP and the QWA's obligations with respect to monitoring, of four principal types: (1) Regulatory monitoring, (2) WIP subwatershed project reach evaluation (to be undertaken by summer interns), (3) Subwatershed TMDL monitoring, and (4) Mainstem TMDL monitoring.

Rocky identified over 100 projects that would take some 20 years to complete, at a cost of more than \$17 million.
