He further reported that the monitoring training program had to be postponed, and that perhaps they can begin the training program in June. He further reported that we now have nine volunteers. The suggestion was made to ask Alan Wood if he would be willing to serve as a data reviewer; Kent agreed to ask him.
- 9. **Hershey Farm for Sale.** Joe reported that the 33-acre Hershey Farm on Dairy Road across from the water treatment plant in North Cornwall Township is up for auction.
