Accordingly, you are hereby notified that this grant is closed, subject to the following conditions:

1. With respect to all costs incurred under the grant, the following represents a final determination of Department of Environmental Protection liability regarding those costs:

Pursuant to this Notice of Grant Closeout, the funds noted on line (c), Balance of State Funds for Deobligation, are hereby deobligated.

2. Closeout of this grant is based on information provided by, and on representations made by, the grantee. Accordingly, the Department of Environmental Protection retains the right to recover disallowed costs or take other appropriate action if the Department determines that such information or representations are false or erroneous.
3. Financial records, supporting documentations, and all other records pertaining to the Agreement shall be retained for a period of not less than three (3) years from the above noted closed date.
4. The Department and the Office of Auditor General, or any of their duly authorized representatives, shall have access to, and the right to examine, any directly pertinent books, documents, papers, and records involving transactions related to the Agreement for a period of three (3) years from the above noted closed date.

Title to real and/or non-expendable personal property purchased with grant funds shall vest in the grantee for so long as the property continues to be used for the purposes of the grant or for any authorized purposes. These uses should have been approved by the Project Advisor prior to the end of the Agreement period. It is the responsibility of the grantee to notify the Department of Environmental Protection when such property is no longer needed or its uses change.
